



CAROL HOMME MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

The Carol Homme Memorial Scholarship is awarded annually in memory of Carol Homme, former member of the Cannon Beach Chorus. She was a talented and energetic musician who participated in numerous musical events and organizations, and she was a vibrant and respected volunteer in community endeavors. The Cannon Beach Chorus is proud to honor her by offering this **\$1,000** scholarship to a graduating high school senior vocalist who is currently enrolled in a choral ensemble, and who is planning to continue choral singing at a four-year college or university.

To Apply for this Scholarship:

1. Submit the application along with two confidential (*sealed*) letters of recommendation from individuals capable of evaluating your musical involvement and participation (*e.g. choral teacher, private voice instructor, church choir director, etc.*)
2. Audition and interview as scheduled with the Cannon Beach Chorus Scholarship Committee.

Audition Requirements: Applicants are expected to perform two accompanied vocal solos from standard vocal literature (*e.g. First Book Series, 26 Italian Series, or Schirmer ed., Young Singer Series, Pathways of Song Series, etc.*) A pianist will be provided if needed.

NOTE: Singing *a cappella* or utilizing CD accompaniments is **not recommended**.

Following the audition, applicants will be interviewed by the CBC Scholarship Committee, consisting of three chorus members and Dr. John Buehler, Cannon Beach Chorus conductor.

If awarded, the scholarship funds will be sent, following enrollment, directly to the business office at the applicant's college/university of choice.

Application Due Date: The scholarship application is due on **Monday, April 15, 2019**.

Auditions/Interviews will be scheduled for **Monday, April 22, 2019**. Auditions are held at the Cannon Beach Community Church, 132 E. Washington, Cannon Beach. Each applicant will be contacted regarding his/her audition time. Parents, friends, and Cannon Beach Chorus members may attend the auditions and interviews.
